Online Specialist Dispatch Project for Kuala Lumpur City Hall J.CLAIR Singapore

With the collaboration from Kuala Lumpur City Hall, J.CLAIR Singapore implemented the Online Specialist Dispatch Project on 17 and 31 January 2023 respectively.

1 Regarding the Specialist Dispatch Project

The Specialist Dispatch Project is implemented with the objective to leverage the administrative capabilities of overseas local governments, as well as to cultivate the human resources needed to further develop overseas local governments. In addition, this project also aims to strengthen the cordial and cooperative ties between Japanese and overseas local governments. Under the project, selected Japanese local government officials are assigned to various overseas local governments so as to conduct lectures and practical trainings on the requested field of expertise. Due to the overwhelming response from Kuala Lumpur City Hall, J.CLAIR Singapore has decided to implement the Specialist Dispatch Project in the online format, so as to accommodate more specialists in various fields to cater to Kuala Lumpur City Hall's needs. This Online Specialist Dispatch Project features 4 specialists from Japan who have conducted a series of online lectures to the local participants in Kuala Lumpur.

2 Outline of the Online Specialist Dispatch Project

(1) Public Engagement

Methods of promoting public engagement among local residents so as to ensure the smooth implementation of urban development

(2) Sports Facilities Management

Operation and management of public sports facilities, in particular improving the existing management system as well as attracting international scale events.

(3) Public Complaint Management

Methods to leverage the public complaint management system so as to fulfil the needs of local residents, especially in terms of improve the efficiency and reduce the overlapping of functions across departments.

(4) Corporate Promotion

Effective mechanisms as well as systems of disseminating information concerning the efforts and initiatives of the city administration to local residents, so as to garner the local citizens' understanding and support.

3 Online lectures by the specialists

Officers from the various related departments in Kuala Lumpur City Hall, as well as representatives from the Malaysia Association of Local Authorities (MALA) participated in a series of online lectures. The lecture on public engagement showcased Mitaka City's initiative of 'Machikoe (Voices of Local Residents)', whereas the lecture on sports facilities management featured a case

study on the Designated Manager System adopted by Fukuoka City's Higashi Hirao Park. On the




Lecture on public engagement (Mitaka City)

4 Conclusion


